Basic Principles

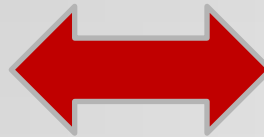
- Tutelage and protection**

constructions

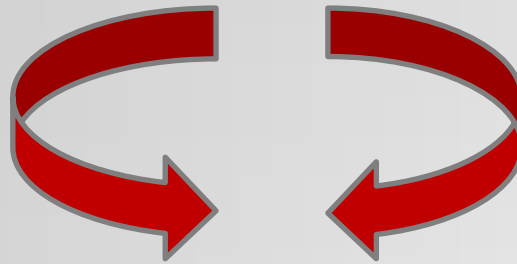
